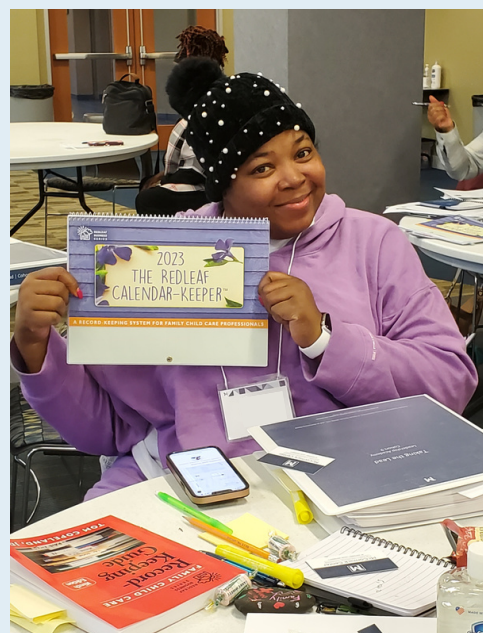
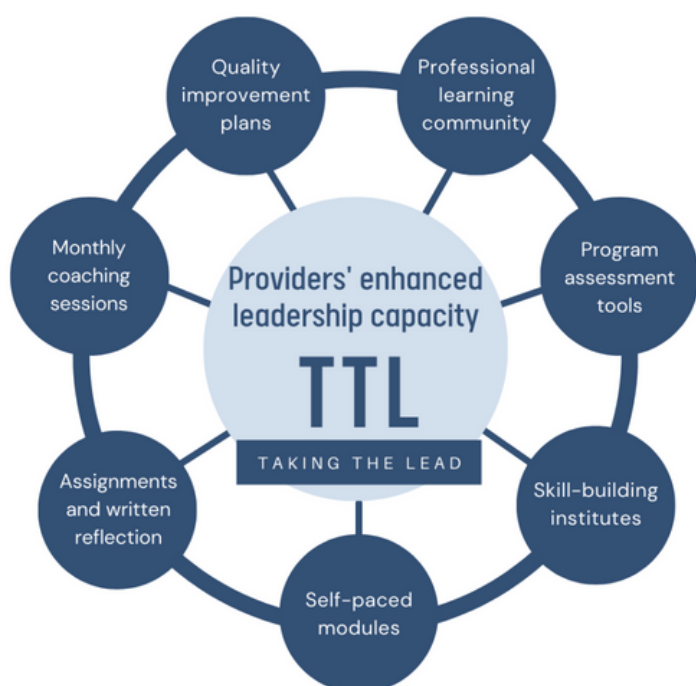

WHAT IS THE TAKING THE LEAD LEADERSHIP ACADEMY?

Taking the Lead (TTL) is designed to support early childhood administrators of home-based programs to grow and sustain their business.

For \$150*, participants receive:
